




SWCS Kindergarten Supply List

<p>1 backpack, large enough to hold a winter coat, a “doc-it” pocket, and a lunch.</p>	
<p>2 heavy duty character or solid-colored portfolio folders.</p>	
<p>1 box of 8 LARGE crayons BASIC colors Crayola brand not necessary.</p>	
<p>1 box of 48 regular size crayons. Crayola brand not necessary. (Nothing bigger will fit in the tote tray of their desk)</p>	
<p>3 Bottles of Elmer’s School Glue, 4oz. (No Larger). We specifically request you get Elmer’s brand due the fact that this brand does not become plugged as often at the opening. (Please, no “no-run”, “gel”, or “glitter” glue.)</p>	
<p>1 pair of blunt nose, good quality scissors. (Fiskars are the best I’ve found for beginners.)</p>	
<p>3 erasers Sanford Magic Rub (white) or Staedtler Mars plastic. (These are both found at Office Dept, Staples and sometimes Wal Mart.)</p>	

<p>1 pencil box Large enough to hold a pencil, scissors, 1 glue bottle, and (either) a box of 48 crayons or 8 large crayons.</p>	
<p>1 large family-size box of tissue for classroom use.</p>	
<p>2 (low odor) EXPO dry erase chisel tip markers. (Darker colors)</p>	
<p>1 letter size (9 x 11/12) envelope or pocket file with ONE single pocket. (Kindergartners have a very difficult time handling the type that has 6 or 13 dividers!)</p> <p>You can find this at several different locations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ <u>Rite Aid on Wheaton Way:</u> 3” Expanding “doc-it” pocket file (their shipments usually come in on a Friday, so the best time to go would be on a Saturday.) ➤ <u>Office Depot or Staples, possibly</u> Document Wallet 3 ½” expanding <p>Or you can get the thin transparent type plastic, usually with Velcro fasteners. These can be found at Target, K-Mart, Wal Mart, etc. This particular type does not hold up very long to Kindergarten abuse.</p>	<p>(Do not purchase file folders, as shown) ONE single pocket, 3” expanding.</p>
